

## WHAT WILL THE TYPICAL AMERICAN OF THE FUTURE LOOK LIKE? HERE IS AN APPROXIMATE ANSWER.

THE COMPOSITE PICTURES IN THE MIDDLE OF THIS PAGE PORTRAY HIM WITH MORE OR LESS ACCURACY.

They are made from twenty-four photographs, twelve profile and twelve full face, of Irish, English, Scotch, Norwegian, Dutch, German, Italian, Magyar, Hebrew, Croatian, Slovak and Polish types, imposed one upon another. These types embrace racially about 85 per cent of the total immigration to America since 1820 and probably more than 75 per cent of the settlers in this country prior to that year. Surrounding the composites are portraits of the twelve types from which they were made. The flood of immigration which has set in this spring, and which promises to break the record, lends timely interest to this pictorial speculation.
